WHAT IS ANGKLUNG?



Angklung is an Indonesian traditional musical instrument made out of bamboo tubes attached to a bamboo frame.

The tubes are carved so that they have a unique resonant pitch when struck. The base of the frame is held with one hand while the other hand shakes the instrument rapidly from side to side.

You just need to shake one to follow the conductor's instruction.

**You don't need skill to play angklung,
we'll teach you just before the performance.**
